Billion Dollar Baby?

The Planned Parenthood Federation of America (PPFA) has become a billion dollar a year corporation, taking in **\$1.0179 billion** in revenues in the fiscal year ending 6/30/07.

Your Tax Dollars at Work

About a third of PPFA's income is in the form of Government Grants and Contracts.

Though it complains about funding cuts, government funding for PPFA has increased in every fiscal year at least as far back as 2001.

Approximately \$120 million of PPFA's funding comes from the federal government.

State funding was responsible for 168,101 U.S. abortions as recently as 2001. Many of these were certainly done at PPFA clinics. The states funding the most abortions in 2001 were:

1. California ... 84,381
2. New York ... 36,131
3. Washington ... 12,397
4. New Jersey 11,514
5. Massachusetts .. 5,874

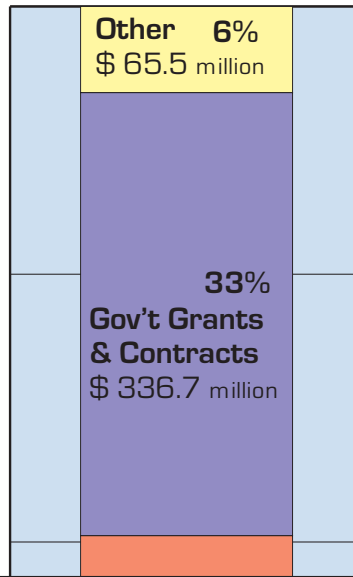
Even when it is specified that funds are not to be used for abortion, that money frees up other funds for abortion performance and advocacy.

That's the way the money goes...

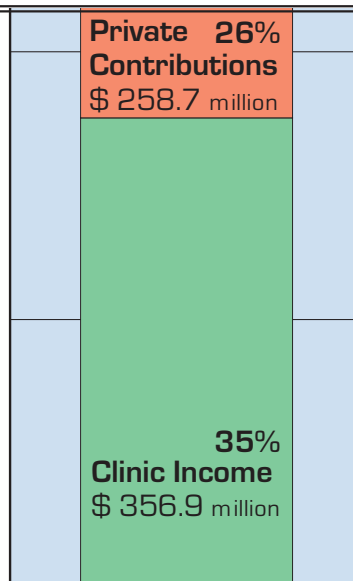
- "Medical Services" (\$588.3 million).
 - "Sexuality Education" (\$48 million) includes PPFA, teenwire.com websites (pro-abortion propaganda, political involvement, info on legally circumventing parental involvement laws, locating clinics, setting appointments).
 - "Public Policy" (\$53.1 million) includes fighting Bush Supreme Court appointments and pro-life laws, supporting pro-abortion activist groups.
 - "Services to the Field of Family Planning" (\$16.4 mil) includes research on RU486 abortion.
 - "Services to Affiliates" (\$23.8 million) includes web referrals for services, politically active Planned Parenthood Action Network.
 - "International Family Planning Programs" (\$7.3 million) includes "safe abortion services," "post-abortion services" for more than 20,000.
 - Admin, Fundraising, Other (\$166.8 million)

Abortion Income

The average cost a woman paid for a standard first trimester suction curettage abortion in in the U.S. in 2005 was \$413.

If every PPFA abortion were a standard first trimester suction abortion, PPFA's income from the 289,750 abortions it performed in 2006 would have been at least **\$119.6 million.**

PPFA clinics advertise and perform more expensive chemical and later term abortions, indicating abortion income is almost certainly higher than \$119.6 million.

Even at \$119.6 million, abortion represents at least a third of PPFA's clinic income.
