- Congressional Scorecard: During his three terms in Congress, Rep. Suozzi earned a 0% pro-life rating from National Right to Life.
- Abortion Without Limits: Rep. Suozzi voted for the "Women's Health Protection Act" (WHPA), a bill that would enshrine abortion in federal law, strike virtually all legal protections for unborn children on the federal and state levels, and prevent the passage of future protections.
- Abortion Funding: The "No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act" would prevent the use of federal funds to pay for abortions on a government-wide basis with exceptions for cases of rape, incest, and to save the life of the mother. Rep. Suozzi voted against the "No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act."
- Late Abortions: Rep. Suozzi voted against the "Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act," which would have protected unborn babies 20 weeks and older from abortions on account of their capacity to feel pain.

- Abortion Funding in the Military: The Biden Administration's Department of Veterans Affairs (V.A.) announced that they will provide and pay for abortions for "health reasons," defined broadly as to be for virtually any reason. Rep. Suozzi supports this new policy and voted against an effort to overturn it.
- Funding Abortion Providers: Rep. Suozzi voted in favor of federal funding for facilities and organizations that perform or refer for abortions, including Planned Parenthood, the nation's largest chain of abortion clinics.
- Born-Alive Infants: Rep. Suozzi voted against the "Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act," a bill that would ensure that an infant born alive during an attempted abortion is afforded the same degree of medical care as any other newborn of the same gestational age.
- Endorsements: Rep. Suozzi has received endorsements from groups that support unlimited abortion like Planned Parenthood Action Fund.
